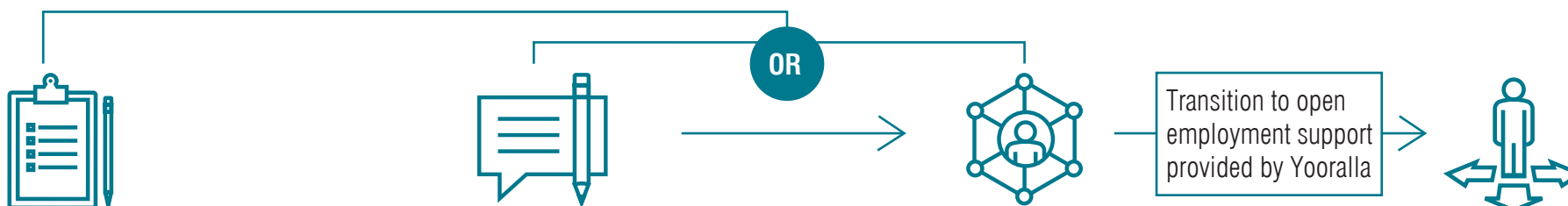


# Employability program

Yooralla's Employability program supports people with disability to learn valuable work skills and engage in meaningful employment. Yooralla can tailor a program to suit your individual needs and capabilities, and support you to transition into the employment that is right for you.



## Yooralla will work with you to develop your training plan and pathway to employment.

Your plan will include the learning outcomes you want, your work goals and how you will achieve them.

Once you have your plan, you will then start in the Employability stream that best suits your needs - either the Preparation for Work or Job Ready streams.

## Preparation for Work

### For school leavers and individuals with basic skills who require intensive support.

A two year program, based in the community, focused on building job skills (education). The participant will move into work experience towards the end of the first year.

In the second year, the participant moves into hands-on work experience and is paid a training wage.

At completion of Preparation for Work, the participant may want to move in to the Job Ready stream.

## Job Ready

### For participants who have completed the Preparation for Work stream.

OR

### People who are at the supported employment level already, and would like to further develop their job skills.

Hands-on one year work placement to prepare the participant for moving into open employment. The participant will be paid to work in supported employment in a Yooralla business enterprise or in the community.

## Open employment

### Participants may be able to transition into a paid job of their choice with an employer in the community.

Yooralla supports people to go into open employment by:

- identifying suitable employment opportunities
- connecting the worker to an employer
- providing mentoring support, and
- coordinating post-placement support.
