Pathfinder Services

... provide planning and support for school leavers who would prefer to choose their own options for pre-vocational and/or adult service pathways. A tailored program can be arranged to suit individual requirements. Assistance in making choices as well as setting up and coordinating support arrangements are provided.

AbleLinks

... delivers pre-vocational courses in:

- Transition Education
- Work Education
- Information technology (linked to Swinburne University)
- Practical Office Skills
- Introduction to Reading and Writing
- Food Safety

To prepare students for employment opportunities, AbleLinks also provides working enterprises that give students hands on experience in food preparation, office skills and multi-media production.

AbleLinks programs are tailored to meet individual needs within a small and supportive environment.

FirstBase Services

...are day services that assist people to map out their lives and goals. Plans are developed on an individualised basis to support people in achieving their personal ambitions. Services are provided in both groups and on an individual basis. Bases are located around Melbourne and in Gippsland.

Steppin' Out Services

... provide support for adults with a range of multiple and complex disabilities, including those who may have behaviours of concern. This day service encourages people to participate in a range of lifestyle activities based on individual preferences.

Home and Community Approach

...this day service supports older adults to create links between their home and local community life. The focus is on building relationships so that individuals can benefit from local community resources and participation.

Community Learning & Living Service

...provides assessment, advocacy, therapy and a ranges of independent living skills to enable adults with a disability to negotiate everyday life according to their individual aspirations, needs and abilities.

With the focus on enhancing individual independence in the home and community, a range of therapy and self-development courses is available that includes assertiveness training, human relations, literacy, technology and public transport training.



Business Services

...Yooralla's business services operate under the name Dual Ware Industries and provide workplace training and supported employment for adults with a disability. All employees are paid under a workplace agreement and are assisted to achieve their individual potential. Employees work as part of a team, are encouraged to have their say in daily operations, and are trained in a range of competencies covering:

- Process work, contract packaging and light assembly
- Operation of machinery including fork-lift driving
- Site administration
- Material handling
- Screen printing
- Direct marketing
