## ComTEC

... provides technology advice to people with disabilities throughout Victoria. Speech pathologists, occupational therapists and an IT support officer are able to provide advice for clients to enable them to acquire specialised equipment and training.

The technology recommended may support communication, computer access, literacy and environmental control. Services provided include a telephone inquiry line, advisory sessions, training, general tours, information sessions, workshops and an electronic equipment library. Appointments are provided at Brooklyn, Blackburn and in the client's own environment.

## The Electronic Communication Devices Scheme

... provides funding and training for electronic communication devices to assist people of all ages who have complex communication needs and who live in Victoria. The scheme provides technology that augments speech or is an alternative to speech. Mounts and switches required to support a communication device are also provided.



## **Independent Living Centre**

... provides information and advice about assistive technology to enhance the quality of life for people with disabilities. It is staffed by specialist health professionals and has two displays at Brooklyn and Blackburn. The services include a telephone enquiry line, web-based database and an education program.

## **ILC.ed**

... provides quality education programs on assistive technology and design to health professionals and interested others and operates on a cost recovery basis.

## Equipment Library

... provides a wide range of specialised equipment for loan. The aim is to help families trial equipment prior to purchase. The equipment is primarily for children and can be loaned for one month. Subscriptions are available.

## Library and Information Service

... provides access to, and delivery of, a diverse range of information essential to support Yooralla staff, people with disabilities, their families, carers, students, and health professionals. A Librarian is available to attend to inquiries, requests, inter-library loans and Internet searches.
