Level 1 Education – Basic

Aim

Level 1 workshops aim to introduce participants to a specific area of assistive technology. Participants will learn how to use equipment safely and to identify features relevant for use with people with disabilities and older people. Level 1 Home Modifications aims to familiarise learners with products and design features that increase the accessibility of home environments.

- Demonstrate competency in basic maintenance of relevant equipment
- Outline important reasons why one type of equipment or design might be used in preference to another
- Anticipate when and where to seek advice and assistance
